CIL OF **OPTING** VIDING **FOR MUNICIPAL CODE ENFORCEMENT**; ESTABLISHING ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURES AND AUTHORITIES; AMENDING CONFLICTING **PROVISIONS** OF CODE: **PROVIDING** CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT WITH OTHER ORDINANCES: PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN

EFFECTIVE DATE.

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WHEREAS, pursuant to Part I of Chapter 162, Florida Statutes, "The Local Government Code Enforcement Boards Act," the Village Council is authorized, at its option, to create and appoint a Village of Estero Code Enforcement Board, to provide for the enforcement of municipal codes; and

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WHEREAS, Part I of Chapter 162, Florida Statutes, also authorizes the appointment of a Special Magistrate to act in conjunction or in lieu of a code enforcement board; and

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WHEREAS, Chapter 162, Part II, Florida Statutes, provides for a "Supplemental Code Enforcement Procedure" whereby duly designated Code Enforcement Officers are authorized to issue citations or notices to appear to a person when, based upon personal investigation, the officer has reasonable cause to believe that the person has committed a civil infraction in violation of a duly enacted code or ordinance; and

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WHEREAS, Chapter 162, Florida Statutes, does not preclude the Village from combining any of the features of Part I and Part II of Chapter 162, nor does it prohibit the Village from enforcing its codes or ordinances by such other means of enforcement as provided by general law or as may lie within the home rule powers of the Village; and

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WHEREAS, the Charter of the Village of Estero, established by Chapter 2014-249, Laws of Florida, provides in Section 11(5) thereto that all applicable ordinances of Lee County contained in the Code of Laws and Ordinances of Lee County, Florida ("Lee County Code") shall, until otherwise affected by the Village Council of the Village of Estero ("Council"), constitute the Code of Laws and Ordinances of the Village of Estero ("Estero Code"); and

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WHEREAS, the Lee County Code, now Estero Code, already provides certain code enforcement procedures best suited to the needs of Lee County; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that maintaining the provisions of certain legacy provisions of the Estero Code relating to code enforcement in Lee County no longer serves the public interest and should be revised to best serve the needs to the Village; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 166, Florida Statutes, the Council has all powers of self-government not inconsistent with general or special law, including the power and authority to adopt ordinances providing for the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Estero.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Village Council of the Village of Estero, Florida:

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Recitals.</u> The above stated recitals are hereby adopted and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby incorporated as a part of this Ordinance.

Section 2. Code Enforcement.

Section 1-1. State Law Implemented

The Village of Estero hereby implements the municipal code enforcement authority provided by Chapter 162, Parts I and II, Florida Statutes, as may be amended from time to time by act of the Legislature. The remainder of this Article is intended to supplement the provisions of Chapter 162 locally.

Section 1-2. Applicability

The provisions of this Article shall apply to and be enforced in all incorporated areas of the Village of Estero as the primary method enforcing the Code of Laws and Ordinances of the Village of Estero, Florida including its land development regulations. Nothing contained in this Article shall prohibit the Village from enforcing its codes or ordinances by any other means.

Section 1-3. Code Enforcement Officials

The Village hereby establishes the following positions and offices for the provision of code enforcement within the Village of Estero:

"Code Enforcement Officer" means any designated employee or agent of the Village whose duty it is to enforce the codes and ordinances of the Village and whose authority is synonymous with designated code enforcement officers or code inspectors as provided in Chapter 162, Florida Statutes.

"Special Magistrate" means any person designated by the Village Council to hold

hearings as provided by Section 162.03, Florida Statutes. Any such magistrate must be at a

minimum an attorney in good standing with the Florida Bar or retired judge or magistrate.

- 1. Finding of Violation. Upon the finding of a code violation by Code Enforcement Officer, the Officer shall have the authority to issue and prosecute notices of violation, citations, summons or notices to appear as necessary and authorized as provided by code and general law.
- 2. Venue. Except in civil actions to enforce Village codes and ordinances, or where a citation or notice appear requires a violator's appearance in county court, violators shall appear before the Village's duly appointed code enforcement board or special magistrate. The rules of procedure for any hearing before either a code enforcement board or special magistrate shall be established by resolution of the Village Council.
- 3. Penalties. The issuance and determination of fines, costs, and liens amounts shall be in the discretion of the code enforcement board or special magistrate as provided by general law. The Village Council may, however, establish a standard fine schedule for the issuance of citations.

Section 3. Amending Conflicting Provisions of Code.

The following provisions of the Estero Code are deleted in their entirety and reserved for future use as follows:

- 1. Chapter 1 Administration, Article VI Code Enforcement Board
- 2. Chapter 1 Administration, Article XI, Public Nuisance Abatement
- 3. Land Development Code, Chapter 1 General Provisions; Section 1-6
- 4. Land Development Code, Chapter 2, Article VII Hearing Examiner

Section 4. Codification. The Village Council intends that this Ordinance be made part of the Code of Laws and Ordinances, of the Village of Estero, Florida; and that sections of this Ordinance can be renumbered or re-lettered to the appropriate word or phrase to accomplish codification, and regardless of whether this Ordinance is ever codified, the Ordinance can be renumbered or re-lettered and typographical errors and clarification of ambiguous wording that do not affect the intent can be corrected with the authorization of the Village Manager without the need for a public hearing.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Conflict with other Ordinances.</u> The provisions of this Article shall supersede any provisions of existing ordinances in conflict herewith to the extent of said conflict.

<u>Section 6.</u> <u>Severability</u>. In the event that any portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

<u>Section 7.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Village Council.
