THE VILLAGE OF ESTERO FUNDED AN AREA WIDE TRAFFIC STUDY THREE OAKS PARKWAY TO BEN HILL GRIFFIN IS OPERATING AT AN UNACCEPTABLE LEVEL OF SERVICE

THE SEGMENT FROM BEN HILL GRIFFIN PARKWAY TO THE PRESERVE AT CORKSCREW IS AT 86% OF P.M. PEAK HOUR CAPACITY

CORKSCREW ROAD GOING FORWARD

ESTERO STUDY PUTS CORKSCREW ROAD AT 178% OF P.M. PEAK HOUR CAPACITY BY 2027 WITHOUR IMPROVEMENTS

THE COUNTY STUDY PUTS CORKSCREW ROAD AT A V/C RATIO OF 2.12 BY 2026 WITHOUT IMPROVEMENTS

WITH IMPROVEMENT THE V/C RATIO IS PROJECTED TO BE .97
