2024-2025 State Legislative Priorities

Motion to Approve the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 Village of Estero Legislative priorities to include.

- 1. Highlands Ave. Septic-to-Sewer
- 2. Sunny Groves UEP
- 3. Estero Bay Village UEP
- 4. Cypress Bend UEP
- 5. Broadway Ave. West Improvements
- 6. River Oaks Preserve

Description:

Village Staff has been working to identify projects that could produce the most benefit to Village residents with State funding in the 2024-2025 Fiscal Year. Village Staff is recommending six Legislative priorities in the following order. Costs are total project costs. The Legislative funding request will be half the project costs.

- 1. Highlands Ave. Septic-to-Sewer Extend water and sewer to properties along Highlands Ave. and County Rd. Including side streets such as Estero Court, Judith Lane, Mockingbird Ln, and Orange Blossom Ln. \$5.33 million
- 2. Sunny Groves UEP Extend sewer to Sunny Groves and demolish their package wastewater treatment plant. \$2.9 million
- 3. Estero Bay Village UEP Extend sewer to Estero Bay Village and demolish their package wastewater treatment plant. \$2.7 million
- 4. Cypress Bend UEP Extend sewer to Cypress Bend and demolish their package wastewater treatment plant. \$1.7 million
- 5. Broadway Ave. West Improvements Design and permit roadway, drainage, and pedestrian improvements along Broadway Ave. West from US 41 to Armada Court. \$1.3 million (does not include construction)
- 6. River Oaks Preserve Plan, design, permit, and construct a storage/restroom building, trails, bridge and extend water, sewer, and reclaimed water to the River Oaks Property. \$2.5 million

Total cost for all six projects - \$16.43 million.

Additional funding would allow these projects to move forward sooner and free up funding for other projects.

Action Requested:

Approve the Fiscal Year 20204-2025 Village of Estero legislative priorities to include.

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- 2. Sunny Groves UEP
- 3. Estero Bay Village UEP
- 4. Cypress Bend UEP
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- 6. River Oaks Preserve

Financial Impact:

There is no financial impact associated with this agenda item. However, if The State approves funding, The Village will be required fund at least 50% of the project's total cost.
