### **Agenda Item:**

March 5, 2019 Election

- (1) Determine Whether to Conduct Early Voting for the March 5, 2019 Election and Choose a Site for Early Voting
- (2) Resolution No. 2018-21 A Resolution of the Village Council of the Village of Estero, Calling for an Election for Village of Estero Council Members; Setting the Date; Providing for Ballot Language; Requesting the Lee County Supervisor of Elections to Conduct the Election and Certify the Results to the Estero Village Council; and Providing an Effective Date

## **Description:**

- (1) The Lee County Supervisor of Elections Office requires early voting notice in advance of the January 2019 candidate qualifying period in order to secure an early voting site and provide training for election workers that will manage the site. Should Council choose to hold early voting, dates for early voting would run from Tuesday, February 26, 2019 through Saturday, March 2, 2019, 10:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m., with an estimated cost of \$13,770.
- (2) Resolution No. 2018-21 has been prepared for adoption in order to meet the requirement to provide advance notice of election dates pursuant to the Election Services Agreement between the Village and the Lee County Supervisor of Elections.

# **Action Requested:**

- (1) Determine whether to conduct early voting for the March 5, 2019 election and choose a site for early voting.
  - (2) Adopt Resolution No. 2018-21.

# **Financial Impacts**:
