The first set of ordinances, those repealing inapplicable provisions of the Lee County code, number 31, and will be adopted in three groups; this is the first group.

Action Requested:

Motion to approve first reading of Ordinances No. 2018-12 through 2018-21 and schedule second reading/public hearing for September 20, 2018.

Financial Impacts:

Approximately \$190 per ordinance for advertising second reading/hearing of the ordinances.
