First reading of Ordinance No. 2018-20 was held on October 3, 2018. At the October 17, 2018 second reading/hearing, concerns were raised that by removing such provisions from the Village Code, the existence of these CDDs may be in jeopardy. The second reading/hearing was subsequently continued on two occasions. Village Legal Counsel has worked to get consensus amongst the various legal counsels of area CDDs.

SUBJECT: Codification Repeal Round One Ordinances – Continued CDD Ordinance

The following are updates to one ordinances continued by the Council for additional legal review.

Ordinance No. 2018-20 (renumbered 2019-13) An Ordinance Repealing Development District Provisions of the Lee County Code Previously Adopted by Reference

The provisions referenced in this ordinance related to the removal of several sections of the Village Code which describe numerous community development districts ("CDD") established by Lee County. Concerns have been raised that by removing such provisions from the Village Code the existence of these CDDs may be in jeopardy. While the concern is understandable, the proposed ordinance will have no impact on the existence of any CDD.

Since this ordinance was first heard by the Council, this office has worked to get consensus amongst the various legal counsels of area CDDs. While responsive parties have agreed that the proposed ordinance does not negatively impact the existence or operation of these CDDs the Village Attorney had recommends continuing this item while awaiting addition responses. Some of the Village's CDDs do not have active management or counsel retained and could not be reached. Due to other mitigating circumstances, namely Hurricane Michael, I was unable to maintain communications with some area CDD counsel, however after consulting with other area CDD counsel I have incorporated additional changes at their request including additional savings and ratification clauses to resolve any ambiguity regarding potential inadvertent impact on existing CDDs.

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Section 2. Ratification.

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The Village hereby ratifies and confirms the establishment, creation and existence of all community development districts within the Village of Estero established by Lee County, including all amendments thereto and any consents provided by Lee County.
