Agenda Item:

Corkscrew Road Design and Permitting

Description:

In response to the residential growth occurring east of the Village of Estero along Corkscrew Road, Lee County is proposing to widen the existing 2-lane Corkscrew Road from Ben Hill Griffin Parkway to Bella Terra. The section from Ben Hill Griffin Parkway to Grande Oaks Way will be widened to 6-lanes and the section from Grande Oaks Way east will be widened to 4-lanes.

As part of this widening project, Lee County is proposing to construct sidewalks, street lights and landscaping. While each of these items will be a benefit to the residents along Corkscrew Road, the sidewalks, street lights and landscaping being proposed by Lee County will match existing Lee County standards. Any enhancements to the sidewalks, street lights or landscaping would need to be done by the Village.

Should Village Council choose to enter into the Corkscrew Road Interlocal agreement with Lee County, design and permitting for the sidewalk, street lights and landscaping will be required. Village Staff is proposing to contract with Johnson Engineering, Inc. to provide these services via a "piggyback" of Lee County Bid No. CN180576ANB which has gone through a competitive bid process. Pursuant to Village of Estero Ordinance No. 2015-06, Section 6. Governmental Contracts; the Village Manager is authorized to enter into bids or contracts entered into by other governmental authorities provided that the governmental authority has followed a competitive bidding procedure leading to the award of the bid or contract in question which is substantially similar to the competitive bidding procedure outlined in this Ordinance.

Staff has attached firm ownership disclosure of greater than 5% as recommended by the Village Attorney.

Action Requested:

Approve the piggybacking of Lee County Bid and the resulting Contract with Johnson Engineering, Inc. to perform a suite of design and permitting services for the Corkscrew Road Widening.

Adopt Resolution No. 2020-06 providing a budget amendment for fiscal year 2019-2020.

Authorize the Village Manager to sign the STA and other additional implementing documents within the scope of the STA on behalf of the Village of Estero Council.

Financial Impact:

The Corkscrew Road Design and Permitting will be added to the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 CIP budget with a budgeted amount of \$571,440. This includes \$519,485 for STA-01 and approximately 10% for project contingency.
