
Project Description:

Install bike lanes on Corkscrew Road between US-41 and Ben Hill Griffin Parkway, where they currently do not exist. Excluding the shared use path proposed in the Coconut Road Shared Use path project.

Project Justification:

The Bicycle & Pedestrian Master Plan identified a lack of east west corridors as a major impediment to bicycle and pedestrian travel in Estero. Corkscrew Road was identified as the preferred main corridor. There are no bicycle facilities along the entire section from US-41 to Ben Hill Griffin Parkway, excluding the bike lanes being installed with the Interchange project. This project will add bike lanes along the roadway. This will improve bicycle/pedestrian access and safety along Corkscrew Road.
