FEMA provided **11 million liters of water**, **6.8 million meals**, tarps, blankets, cots, medical equipment and other commodities to the state for distribution.





## RECOVERY

- **\$1.60 billion** in U.S. Small Business Administration disaster loans approved.
- 45,800 National Flood Insurance Program claims submitted. \$2.29 billion paid to 30,800 claimants.
- U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Blue Roof Mission completed; **20,119** Blue Roofs installed.
- Nearly 126,500 visits to Disaster Recovery Centers.
- Disaster Survivor Assistance teams have interacted with **153,198** disaster survivors in designated counties.
- 1,132 households (2,735 members) sheltered in Transitional Sheltering Assistance.
- **\$966.1 million** in Individual Assistance for **377,771** households.
  - Housing Assistance approved: **\$617.1 million**
  - Other Needs Assistance approved: \$349.0 million
- Total of **185** applicants have been licensed-in for Direct Housing.
- There are 39 projects obligated for \$547.8 million (Federal Share obligated) for Public Assistance.
- Amount Obligated Federal Share:
  - Debris Removal: \$114 million
  - Protective Measures: \$397 million
