12	\$5,029,690 for the fiscal year 2015-2016, which includes a prior year surplus of \$1,096,170

15	WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2015-15 budget amendment for fiscal year 2015-2016
16	was adopted on October 7, 2015, resulting in total Village of Estero revenue of \$11,537,620
17	total Village of Estero expenditures of \$7,345,800, and Projected Fund Balance at end of fisca
18	year 2015-2016 of \$5,287,990; and

20	WHEREAS, the following contracts have been approved and require appropriation in
21	the 2015-2016 Budget: (a) Legislative Lobbying services for \$17,500; (b) Infrastructure
22	Inventory services for \$16,113; (c) Village Manager contract additional budgeted fund
23	totaling \$15,680; and

25	WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2015-12 approved the establishment of a Community
26	Development Department and an estimated cost for Information Technology (IT) Equipmen
27	for the new department has been developed of \$56,900, which includes hardware for new
28	location, computer, printers, software, and copier; and
29 30	WHEREAS, the contracts for Estero Planning Initiative and Flood Plain - Community
31	Rating were budgeted but not fully expended in the 2014-2015 fiscal year. The unexpended
32	portion of these contracts is available to carry forward into the Budget for the 2015-2016 fisca
33	year. These carry forwards will increase the prior year surplus and expenditures but will no
34	reduce projected fund balance; and

36	WHEREAS, Staff has consulted with the Village auditors regarding the reporting o
37	restricted Impact Fee funds. Staff It is recommending ed that the Village establish a Capita
38	Projects fund to account for the restricted Impact Fee funds as well as the future Capita
39	Improvement Projects. 2015-2016 Impact Fee Budgeted Revenue and Fund Balance need to
40	be allocated to a new Capital Projects Fund.

75	The General Fund Balance totals \$3,788,490 with \$1,555,490 in unrestricted, \$2,000,000 in				
76	emergency reserves and \$233,000 in excess building fees.
