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14	WHEREAS, the Village Council is the governing body in and for the Village of
15	Estero; and
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17	WHEREAS, on September 7, 2016, the Village and Lee County, Florida, acting by
18	and through its Board of County Commissioners, entered into an Agreement for Municipal
19	Solid Waste Collection, Billing, Customer Services and Disposal (hereinafter "CBD
20	Agreement") and Agreement for A Municipal Solid Waste Disposal Facilities Assessment
21	(hereinafter the "MSW Assessment Agreement"; and
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23	WHEREAS, pursuant to the CBD Agreement, the County provides the Village with
24	solid waste collection, billing and disposal services for newly constructed residential and
25	multi-family units, including prefabricated units, and disposal for commercial buildings
26	within the Village limits; and
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28	WHEREAS, pursuant to the MSW Agreement, the County and Village agreed to the
29	establishment of Municipal Solid Waste Disposal Facilities Assessment (hereinafter the
30	"Program") to provide a mechanism for payment of certain costs for the disposal of
31	municipal solid waste through the County's Solid Waste and Resource Recovery System; and
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33	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section IV, B, 1, of the MSW Assessment Agreement and
34	Section 125.01(1)(q), Florida Statutes, the Village hereby consents to, ratifies, and authorizes
35	the County to levy the special assessments within Village boundaries under the Program
36	outlined in the above referenced agreements.
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38	NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Village Council of the Village of Estero
39	Florida:
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41	Section 1. Authorization.
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43	Pursuant to § 125.01(1)(q), Florida Statutes, the Village hereby consents to, ratifies
44	and authorizes Lee County to levy the special assessments within Village boundaries under the
45	Program.

The authority hereby authorized shall be exercised in accordance with the terms of the Agreements referenced above and shall be for the term of the Agreement beginning on September 7, 2016 until September 30, 2020.

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Section 2. Severability.

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If any part, section, subsection, or other portion of this Ordinance or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is declared void, unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such part, section, subsection, or other portion of the prescribed application thereof, shall be severable, and the remaining provisions of this Ordinance, and all applications thereof not having been declared void, unconstitutional or invalid, shall remain in full force and effect. The Village declares that no invalid or prescribed provision or application was an inducement to the enactment of this Ordinance, and that it would have enacted this Ordinance regardless of the invalid or prescribed provision application.

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Section 3. Scrivener's Errors.

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Sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered, and typographical errors which do not affect the intent may be authorized by the Village Manager, or the Village Manager's designee, without need of Public Hearing, by filing a corrected or recodified copy of same with the Village Clerk.

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Section 4. Conflict of Law.

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In the event that any provision in this Ordinance is found to be contrary to any other existing Village Ordinance covering the same subject matter, then in said event the more restrictive shall apply.

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Section 5. Effective Date.

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This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
