	WHEREAS, the Village of Estero was incorporated by referendum held on November		
	4, 2014; and		
	WHEREAS, the Charter of the Village of Estero ("Charter") at Section 11, "General		
	Provisions," paragraph (5) "Transitional Ordinances and Resolutions," provides that all		
	applicable lawful Lee County ordinances currently in place at the time of passage of the		
	referendum, unless specifically referenced in the Charter, shall remain in place unless		
	rescinded by the Village Council or unless they are in conflict with an ordinance, rule or		
	regulation of the Village; and		
	WHEREAS, the Village Council has determined that it is in the best interests and		
	welfare of the Village and its residents to revise certain provisions of the Lee County Code to		
	specifically apply to the Village.		
	NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Village Council of the Village of Estero,		
	Florida:		
	Section 1. Lee County Code Sections amended.		
	The following sections were included in the Code of Laws and Ordinances, of the		
	Village of Estero, Florida by virtue of their inclusion in the Lee County Code and are hereby		
	amended as ordinances of the Village of Estero. These amendments are not intended to affect		
	the validity of these provisions as laws of Lee County.		
	Lee County Code Chapter 22 ¹ / ₂ Mobile Homes, previously adopted by reference i amended to read as follows.		
	amended to read as follows.		
	Sec 221/ 1 Manual market and		
	Sec. 22 ¹ / ₂ -1. Move-on permit required.		
	It shall be unlawful for any owner, purchaser, dealer or installer of a mobile home to		
	move such mobile home onto a site in Estero without first obtaining a move-on permit from		
	the village.		

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45 Sec. 22¹/₂-2. Permit to be obtained before mobile home in moved, to describe premises 46 and to be posted.

The move-on permit shall be obtained before the mobile home is moved and shall specifically describe the premises on which the mobile home is to be sited. The permit shall be posted prominently on the mobile home before such mobile home is moved onto the site.

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Sec. 22¹/₂-3. Violations and penalties.

A purchaser, owner, mover, installer or dealer, whoever in each case actually moves the mobile home, shall be guilty of a violation of this chapter if he moves such mobile home onto a site without first obtaining and posting the required move-on permit.

58 Violation of this chapter shall be a misdemeanor punishable as provided by law. In 59 addition, the board of county commissioners or its designated agency may move or require 60 removal, at owner's or mover's expense, of a mobile home which is placed on a site without a 61 proper move-on permit. Violations of this chapter by Florida installers or movers shall be 62 reported to the Florida Public Service Commission; violations by out-of-state installers or 63 movers will be reported as complaints to the interstate commerce commission.

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Section 2. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
