1 VILLAGE OF ESTERO 2 3 **ORDINANCE NO. 2019 - 30** 4 5 AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE 6 VILLAGE OF ESTERO, FLORIDA, ANNEXING PROPERTY 7 LOCATED AT 4528, 4406 AND 4410 COCONUT ROAD, LEE 8 COUNTY, FLORIDA, INTO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF 9 THE VILLAGE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ANNEXATION 10 PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 171, FLORIDA STATUTES; REDEFINING THE BOUNDARY LINES OF SAID VILLAGE IN 11 AMENDING 12 CONFORMANCE THEREWITH: 13 OFFICIAL BOUNDARY MAP OF THE VILLAGE OF ESTERO, 14 FLORIDA, PROVIDING THAT EXISTING FUTURE LAND 15 USE AND ZONING DESIGNATIONS REMAIN 16 CHANGED BY THE VILLAGE ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; 17 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 18 19 WHEREAS, Headwaters Coconut Road General Partnership ("Property Owner") has 20 21 initiated a voluntary annexation of real property, located at 4528 Coconut Road and 4406/4410 Coconut Road, Lee County, Florida ("the Properties") as described and depicted in Exhibit "A" 22 23 and Exhibit "B", attached hereto; and, 24 25 WHEREAS, the Village has identified certain lands that are logical for annexation into the 26 Village, the appropriate land uses and infrastructure needs for said areas, and the provider of 27 services and infrastructure for said areas; and, 28 29 WHEREAS, the Property Owner, before seeking annexation into the Village, was proceeding with its development plans before Lee County and, though desirous of annexation into 30 31 the Village, the Property Owner does not wish to restart the development review process, or add 32 complexity or delay to its plans; and 33 34 WHEREAS, in recognition of the foregoing, the Village has agreed to expeditiously process 35 the Property Owner's application; and 36 37 WHEREAS, in order to accommodate the Property Owner and in recognition of its existing 38 rights under the Comprehensive Plan and Land Development Regulations of Lee County for a 39 period of 24 months or until otherwise superseded by inclusion into Village Comprehensive Plan; 40 and 41 42 WHEREAS, for the foregoing transition period, the Lee County Comprehensive Plan and

Land Development Regulations, along with Lee County impact and permit fees, shall continue to

apply; and

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WHEREAS, with the exception of the Village's Design Review Board, all Village 46 47 procedural requirements will apply during the transition period; and 48 49 WHEREAS, the properties to be annexed shall retain the Comprehensive Plan Future Land Use and Zoning classifications existing at the time this Ordinance is approved subject to the 50 51 aforementioned time limits; unless otherwise requested by the Property Owner, the properties will become subject to the Village Comprehensive Plan Future Land Use and Zoning classifications 52 53 most consistent with the retained classifications upon subsequent action by the Village. 54 55 **NOW, THEREFORE,** be it ordained by the Village Council of the Village of Estero, Florida: 56 The foregoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by 57 Section 1. 58 reference. 59 60 The Village Council, after first reading on December 4, 2019 and duly Section 2. advertised public hearing on January 8, 2020 continued to January 22, 2020, hereby adopts 61 Ordinance 2019-30, annexing the properties into the Village of Estero municipal boundary. 62 63 The Property Owner's exclusive remedy to address any Village obligation 64 contained in this Ordinance shall be through a petition for contraction pursuant to Chapter 171, 65 66 Florida Statutes. 67 68 Section 4. Conflict. 69 The provisions of this article shall supersede any provisions of existing ordinances in conflict 70 herewith to the extent of said conflict. 71 72 Section 5. Severability.
