## NOTE: The deadline for receipt of bids has been changed. It is now February 27, 2023, at 2:00 p.m.

In response to questions from interested bidders, the following information is provided.

Question 1: Does the Village know how many miles or linear feet of removal this project consists of?

Village Response: The combined length of cleanout area for the Estero River main channel, south branch, and north branch is approximately 1.1 miles. Please note that the trees needing to be removed are scattered throughout this area and are not a continual blockage. The pictures included in the original bid package identify most of the locations with the exceptions of trees and limbs totally submerged.

Question 2: Page 4 of the RFP states that we must provide copies of all necessary permits or licenses with bid submittal. Is a Florida contractor's license required for this project?

Village Response: A Florida contractor's license is not required. However, it is the Contractor's responsibility to ensure that all related marine licenses – such as those that may be required through the FDEP – be obtained prior to any work being performed.

Question 3: Where is the location for boat launch? Please attach a map. Village Response: A map showing the access point (the red outlined white area) adjacent to the Estero River Outfitters location is shown below.



Question 4: Will the Village of Estero allow access into the river to plan the project, conduct depth checks and height variations under bridges?

Village Response: Interested bidders are encouraged to access the river to plan the project, check depths, etc. The access location has not been bushhogged so it may be easier to rent a canoe or kayak from the adjacent Estero River Outfitters, but interested bidders are able to use the identified access point at their choice. It is requested that interested bidders contact Mr. Bob Franceschini, Procurement Director, prior to accessing river if using the access point on the Village's property.
