


PROJECT FACT SHEET Sandy Lane Corkscrew Road to East Broadway

About the Enhancements on Sandy Lane

Currently there are no biking facilities or sidewalks along Sandy Lane. To improve bicycle and pedestrian connectivity and safety, a 12-foot shared use path on the east side of the road is proposed. Separating vehicles from bicyclists and pedestrians can encourage more cyclists and walkers of all ages to use Sandy Lane.

The example cross sections below are intended to be illustrative and do not reflect engineering level details. The improvement costs reflect planning level estimates only and do not include the cost for a proposed bridge to span the Estero River.
