Recommended Action: Motion to set public hearing date of May 23, 2018 at 9:30 a.m. Florida Statutes require one of the two required comprehensive plan public hearings to be held after 5:00 p.m. unless the Council votes to set a different time.

(b) Approval of Land Development Code (RFQ 2017-01) Professional Services Agreement between Village of Estero and Clarion Associates

Recommended Action: Motion to approve the agreement for professional services with Clarion Associates for the Land Development Code.

Financial Impacts: Contract amount: \$322,865 - There is \$250,000 currently budgeted over two fiscal years commencing in 2017-2018. In addition, \$45,000 has been budgeted for assistance from the Village's land use counsel, Nancy Stroud, for the same time period. Additional funds are available in the general funding operating contingency if needed. Staff plans to revise the total cost of the Land Development Code in the fiscal year 2018/19 budget process to reflect actual contractual obligations.

(c) Approval of Award of Request for Bids No. RFB 2018-05 to P&T Lawn and Tractor Service, Inc.

Recommended Action: Motion to: (1) Approve award of Request for Bids No. RFB 2018-05, Roadway Irrigation Maintenance for the Village of Estero to P&T Lawn and Tractor Service, Inc. to provide irrigation system maintenance services as provided in the contract for a one year period, at the rates listed in the contract (including all Options). (2) Authorize the Village Manager to execute the contract documents on behalf of the Village of Estero Council. (3) Grant the Village Manager the authority to renegotiate and execute the renewal of this contract for one additional one year term under the same terms and conditions, if doing so is in the best interest of the Village of Estero.

Financial Impacts: The Estero Parkway irrigation system will be inspected ten times annually at a cost of \$285 per inspection for a total annual cost of \$2,850. Parts and components required to make repairs will be billed as needed at a rate of 115% of vender's cost. A total of \$10,600 funding is provided in the 2017-2018 fiscal year budget for irrigation maintenance services (001-265-5413405).
