Dear Mr. Hart.


My firm serves as Manager for the Stoneybrook CDD. The CDD Board has reviewed the proposed plans, with its staff, and have the following concerns, in no particular order:

- 1) The proposal to be a 24 hour a day operation, including an automatic car wash. Needless to say, being that the proposed operation is situated in such close proximity to a school and residential community will undoubtedly have significant negative impacts in the form of noise and light pollution and is not consistent with the anticipated/proposed use that the residents relied upon when purchasing their homes.
- 2) Traffic volume and flow on and off of Corkscrew Road. The proposed operation will add a significant amount of additional traffic volume to an already strained intersection particularly during times of school arrivals and departures (bus and parent pick-ups and drop offs)
- 3) Stoneybrook Golf Drive. We question whether this road is built to a standard and capacity to handle the volume and anticipated large sized vehicles that would be frequenting the proposed operation.
- 4) Environmental concerns. The proposed operation presents significant concerns for the high probability of fuel, oil and grease discharging from the operation and into the Stoneybrook Storm Water System (SWS), which is also a head water for the vast preserve to the south of Stoneybrook. Since Stoneybrook is the permit holder for the SWS, the CDD/community could find itself intertwined in a costly abatement and remediation effort from the long term discharge, of oils and greases during rain events or from a catastrophic spill event, into its SWS.

Thankyou in advance for your consideration of these concerns and please let me know if you need anything additional from the CDD.
