**A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE
VILLAGE OF ESTERO, FLORIDA, ADOPTING AND
AGREEING TO FOLLOW THE LEE COUNTY
COMPREHENSIVE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT
PLAN; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, Chapter 252, Florida Statutes, assigns to the Board of County Commissioners of Lee County responsibility for disaster preparedness, response, recovery and mitigation; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Lee County passed and adopted Resolution No. 13-12-30 on December 17, 2013, approving and adopting the Lee County Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Estero, lying within Lee County, finds it in the best interest of public health, safety, and general welfare of the Village and its residents and property owners that the Village of Estero adopt by reference and agree to follow the Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan adopted by the Lee County Board of County Commissioners.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Village Council of the Village of Estero, Florida:

Section 1. The Village Council of the Village of Estero hereby adopts the Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan by reference and agrees to follow the Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan adopted by the Lee County Board of County Commissioners.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
