20	participation to any and all interested parties; and

22	WHEREAS, the Working Group has identified these local hazards and has reassessed
23	the county-wide vulnerability and risk to these hazards based on the most recent scientific and
24	technically based risk assessment techniques; and

26	WHEREAS, the Working Group has identified and prioritized mitigation initiatives
27	that would reduce local vulnerability to these hazards; and

29	WHEREAS, the Local Mitigation Strategy has been updated to reflect the knowledge
30	gained from disasters that Lee County and the incorporated municipalities therein have
31	experienced over the past year; and

33	WHEREAS, projects identified in the Local Mitigation Strategy Mitigation Initiatives
34 35	List are given more consideration by federal and state managed funding programs; and
36	WHEREAS, the Local Mitigation Strategy can serve as the Flood Mitigation Plan as
37	required of all communities participating in the National Flood Insurance Program and seeking
38	project funding from the Flood Mitigation Assistance Program; and
39	project faileding from the Front mitigation rispistance i fogram, and
40	WHEREAS, the Local Mitigation Strategy is designed to be a process-oriented
41	document with review and revision policies that allow the Local Mitigation Strategy to be
42	changed to meet new or changing conditions including hazard-event frequency, perceived local
43	needs and funding opportunities.
