12	LEGISLATURE MAKE NO ATTEMPT TO PREEMPT
13	LOCAL GOVERNMENT EFFORTS TO BAN SUCH
14	ACTIVITIES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

16	WHEREAS, well stimulation including acid stimulation, hydraulic fracturing, and
17	acid fracturing is the process of injecting liquid into subterranean rocks and substrates so as to
18	fracture or dissolve the formation for the exploration and extraction of oil or natural gas; and
19	
20	WHEREAS, Florida's water supply comes from highly permeable limestone
21	formations which are vulnerable to contamination from the chemicals utilized in such
22	activities; and
23	WITEDEAS the Willow of Estano ante all of its water from aroundwater sources; and
24 25	WHEREAS, the Village of Estero gets all of its water from groundwater sources; and
26	WHEREAS, well stimulation including acid stimulation, hydraulic fracturing, and
20 27	acid fracturing pose potential risks of contaminating the aquifers which are the source of
28	drinking water for the residents and visitors to the Village of Estero; and
29	annang water for the restaction and visitore to and visitore of 200000, and
30	WHEREAS, additionally, well stimulation including acid stimulation, hydraulic
31	fracturing, and acid fracturing often involve the use of substantial amounts of freshwater at a
32	time when many Florida's water resources are stressed and there is a need to preserve future
33	water supplies for use by future residents and visitors to our state.
34	
35	NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Village Council of the Village of Estero,
36	Florida:

38	Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by
39	this reference.

41	Section 2. The Village Council of the Village of Estero hereby proclaims their
42	support for a statewide ban on well stimulation, including acid stimulation, hydraulic
43	fracturing, and acid fracturing, and requests that the Legislature and Governor enact such a ban
44 45	and not adopt any law which seeks to limit or preempt the ability of local governments to limit such activities in the interests of public safety and the protection of natural resources.
