5	A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE

9	OF BONITA SPRINGS IN ZONING HEARINGS

11	PROPOSALS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

13	WHEREAS, the Village Council has determined that it is in the best interests and
14	welfare of the Village and its residents to participate in City of Bonita Springs ("City") zoning
15	hearings related to the proposals by Pelican Landing Golf Resort Ventures LP to amend the
16	Pelican Landing RPD/CPD to allow the development of four residential towers within the
17	Pelican Landing Golf Resort (aka Raptor Bay); and
18	WHERE AC 4b a William Council has determined that the manner of development man
19 20	WHEREAS, the Village Council has determined that the proposed development may have adverse impacts on the public infrastructure, aesthetics, safety, amenities, natural
21	environment, and other significant public interest concerns of current and potential future
22	residents in the Village; and
23	residents in the vinage, and
24	WHEREAS, the Village Council has contracted with an expert traffic engineer to
25	study the traffic impacts of the proposed development and the study is in process; and
26	
27	WHEREAS, Section 163.3178(1), Florida Statutes, expresses the legislative intent
28	that local governments restrict development activities where such activities would damage or
29	destroy coastal resources and that such plans protect human life and limit public expenditures
30	in areas that are subject to destruction by natural disasters; and
31	With the control of t
32	WHEREAS, the Village Council is concerned, among other things, that hurricane
33 34	evacuation times and shelter capacity are currently inadequate and that increased density at the Raptor Bay location will further exacerbate evacuation problems; and
35	Rapiol Bay location will further exacerbate evacuation problems, and
36	WHEREAS, the Village's current staff and consultants, including but not limited to
37	Community Development Director Mary Gibbs and Land Use Counsel Nancy Stroud, have
38	expertise that can be provided as testimony in the City's zoning hearings, including but not
39	limited to traffic and transportation, coastal high hazard area protection, hurricane evacuation,
40	comprehensive planning, and zoning; and

42	WHEREAS, the Village Council wishes to ensure that the expert testimony relevant
43	to the Village's concerns is provided to the City of Bonita Springs zoning hearings.
44	
45	NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Village Council of the Village of Estero,
46	Florida:

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Section 1. The Village Council authorizes the Village Manager to coordinate the provision of expert testimony from Village staff and consultants as appropriate and necessary to the City of Bonita Springs zoning hearings related to the Pelican Landing/Raptor Bay development proposals and to continue to explore the merits of jurisdictional and procedural legal challenges to these matters as authorized by Village Council prior resolution on the matter at Council meeting of January 13, 2016. The expert testimony shall be provided to the hearings held before the City Zoning Board for Land Use Hearings, before the City Council, and Local Planning Agency.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
