RESOLUTION NO. 2016 - 26

A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF ESTERO, LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE LEVYING OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE VILLAGE OF ESTERO, LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2016-2017; ESTABLISHING THE DATE, TIME AND PLACE FOR A FINAL HEARING TO ADOPT THE FINAL AD VALOREM TAXES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2016-2017; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Village of Estero, Lee County, Florida, on September 7, 2016, adopted Fiscal Year Tentative Millage Rate following a public hearing as required by Florida Statutes 200.065; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Estero, Lee County, Florida, held a public hearing as required by Florida Statutes 200.065; and

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within the Village of Estero, Lee County, Florida has been certified by the Lee County Property Appraiser to the Village of Estero as \$6,113,369,290;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Village Council of the Village of Estero, Florida:

**Section 1.** The fiscal year 2016-2017 tentative ad valorem operating millage rate for tax (calendar) year 2016 is hereby adopted at .8398 mills, which is greater than the rolled-back rate of .8004 mills by 4.92% and the levy of an annual tax for said year is tentatively made.

**Section 2.** A public meeting and hearing will be held to consider and adopt the final millage rate for fiscal year 2016-2017 as follows:
