34	List are given more consideration by federal and state managed funding programs; and

36	WHEREAS, the Local Mitigation Strategy can serve as the Flood Mitigation Plan as
37	required of all communities participating in the National Flood Insurance Program and seeking
38	project funding from the Flood Mitigation Assistance Program; and
