13	WHEREAS, the Village requires landscape design services; and		
14			
15	WHEREAS, the proposed contract with Windham Studio, Inc. was found to be		
16	sufficient for the Village's needs. Windham Studio, Inc. has extensive, local experience		
17	providing landscape design services for municipalities in Lee County and Collier County; and		
18			
19	WHEREAS, the Village has been approached by the Florida Department of		
20	Transportation (FDOT) concerning potentially available landscape capital funds, contingent		
21	upon the Village providing a cost estimate in short order. A bidding process would extend		
22	beyond FDOT's allowable timeframe, based on their budgeting timeline.		
23			
24	WHEREAS, the proposal has an estimated, one-time cost of \$12,800, with a not-to-		
25	exceed value of \$20,000, to be funded from the current 2016-2017 budget; and		
26			
27	WHEREAS, staff is recommending a waiver of the competitive bidding procedures as		
28	provided in Ordinance No. 2015-06, Section 5, and requests authorization of the Village		
29	Manager to execute a contract with Windham Studio, Inc. as provided in Ordinance No. 2015-		
30	06, Section 2(B).

32	NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Village Council of the Village of Estero,		
33	Florida:		
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35	Section 1. The competitive bid process is waived and the Village Manager is		
36	hereby authorized to execute a contract with Windham Studio, Inc.

38	Section 2. The fiscal impact of the contract is estimated at \$12,800, which		
39	represents a one-time payment for the current fiscal year. This will be funded from the current		
40	2016-2017 budget.
