12	WHEREAS, it was estimated that \$150,000 would be expended in the prior fiscal year
13	for build out of new office space with an additional \$25,000 budgeted in 2017-2018; however,
14	we have experienced delays in the architectural drafting process and all of the funds will be
15	expended in fiscal year 2017-2018; and

17	WHEREAS, it is anticipated that \$220,000 will be needed to complete build out of the
18	new office space include equipment and furniture purchases. As \$150,000 was allocated in
19	2016/2017 and an additional \$25,000 was budgeted in 2017/2018; the net increase in funding
20	from the Village will be \$45,000 and funds are available in unappropriated prior year surplus.
21	The 2017/2018 budget amendment is needed for \$195,000 as the amount from the prior fiscal
22	year needs to be carried forward; and
23	year needs to be earried for ward, and
24	WHEREAS, As provided in the Village Charter Section 8(6)(d), the following
25	additional expenditures will be added to the 2017-2018 Budget as a new appropriation.
26	additional expenditures will be added to the 2017 2010 Budget as a new appropriation.
27	NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Village Council of the Village of Estero,
28	Florida:

30	Section 1. An increase of \$195,000 in budgeted expenditures will be added to the
31	General Fund Capital Outlay budget (001.800.5136400) which will be funded from
32	unappropriated prior year surplus.

34	Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
