5	A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE
6	VILLAGE OF ESTERO, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING
7	CERTAIN POLICIES WITH RESPECT TO MUNICIPAL
8	CODE ENFORCEMENT; PROVIDING FOR DELEGATION
9	OF AUTHORITY TO THE VILLAGE SPECIAL
10	MAGISTRATE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
11	
12	WHEREAS, the Village Council previously adopted Ordinance 2015-14, fully
13	adopting the authority of "The Local Government Code Enforcement Boards Act" contained
14	in Chapter 162, Parts I and II, Florida Statues; and
15	
16	WHEREAS, the Village has elected to utilize a Special Magistrate in lieu of a code
17	enforcement board but also specifically retained all supplemental code enforcement procedures
18	authorized under said Act, including the issuance of citations and initiation of civil actions to
19	enforce its municipal codes; and
20	
21	WHEREAS, the Village Council believes that it is in the best interests of the residents
22	and visitors of the Village of Estero to enforce its municipal codes to the maximum extent
23	permitted by law.
24	
25	NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Village Council of the Village of Estero,
26	Florida:
27	
28	Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true
29	and correct and are hereby made a part of this Resolution and adopted as policy findings.
30	
31	Section 2. The Village Council hereby authorizes its Village Manager and Village
32	Attorney, as well as its code enforcement staff, to pursue enforcement of Village regulations
33	and to recover such associated costs thereto, to the maximum extent allowable by law.
34	
35	Section 3. The Village Council hereby authorizes its Village Manager and Village
36	Attorney, as well as its code enforcement staff, to negotiate settlement of code enforcement
37	liens only where the compliance has been achieved and the Village's costs of enforcement and
38	abatement, if any, are recovered and the Village's interest is further protected by the entry of
39	a cease and desist order to ensure continued compliance.

41	Section 4. The Village Council hereby delegates authority to reduce liens imposed
42	by the Village's Special Magistrate to the Special Magistrate, consistent with the policy
43	directives provided herein, upon recommendation by the Village Manager and Village
44	Attorney, or their designees. Notwithstanding the forgoing, the Special Magistrate will forward
45	lien reduction requests where the liens exceed \$100,000 and may forward lien reduction
