21	Section 1 Description No. 2016 00 is amended to add the Executive Assistant to
22 23	Section 1. Resolution No. 2016-09 is amended to add the Executive Assistant to Directors position as eligible under Section 3-03 Paid Time Off (PTO) item A.2.:
23 24	Directors position as engine under section 3-03 raid Time On (FTO) item A.2
25	"Any unused PTO will lapse on September 30th of each year, except that Directors and
26	the Executive Assistant to Directors may buy-out, that is, be paid for up to forty (40) hours of
27	unused PTO at September 30th, so long as payment is made on or before September 30th in
28	compliance with Village Charter, Section 4 (6) (c), which prohibits unfunded liabilities."

30	Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
