12 13 14	WHEREAS, the Village of Estero places the highest premium on safety of life; and
15 16 17 18	WHEREAS, both the World Health Organization and federal Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recognize the novel and virulent danger posed by COVID-19, having declared it a worldwide pandemic; and
19 20 21 22	WHEREAS, Governor Ron DeSantis signed Executive Orders 20-52 in response to the novel and virulent nature of the and has declared a public health emergency, pursuant to Chapter 252, Florida Statutes; and
23 24 25	WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, President Donald Trump declared a national state of emergency concerning COVID-19; and
26 27 28 29	WHEREAS, at the time of the execution of this resolution, the CDC and Florida Surgeon General have recognized a present danger to residents of Florida from the outbreak; and
30 31 32 33	WHEREAS, Chapter 252, Florida Statutes, authorizes municipalities to declare a state of local emergency and to waive procedures and formalities otherwise required of municipalities to take whatever prudent action is necessary to ensure the health, safety, and welfare of the Village in the event of a state of local emergency; and
34 35 36 37	<b>WHEREAS</b> , the Village of Estero relies on the Village Council and staff for leadership during emergencies; and
38 39 40	WHEREAS, it is the duty of the Village to take such protective measures and to coordinate its efforts in support of the public health and safety of the community; and
41 42 43	WHEREAS, there may be instances when it is difficult or impossible to obtain a quorum of Council membership for the purpose of convening an emergency meeting during a state of local emergency; and
44 45 46 47 48	WHEREAS, the Village Council finds it in the public interest to be proactive in emergency operations and to coordinate its efforts with national, state, and local health officials; and

19 50 51	WHEREAS, the Village Council desires to designate and delegate to the Village Manager the authority provided under Chapter 252 to respond to the emergency should a quorum of the Village Council be physically unable to meet.

53 54	<b>NOW, THEREFORE,</b> be it resolved by the Village Council of the Village of Estero, Florida, that the Village of Estero hereby declares a State of Local Emergency.
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56 57	<u>Section 1</u> . The Village Council of the Village of Estero, Florida, in conjunction with Lee County, hereby declares a state of local emergency and the Council desires the Village
58 59	Manager to avail himself to all powers available to Village government provided in Chapter 252, Florida Statutes, the Village Code, and all other powers set forth in any Executive Order

58	a. Performance of public work and taking whatever action is necessary to
