30	WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, President Donald Trump declared a national state of				
31	emergency concerning COVID-19; and

33	WHEREAS, the Village Council adopted Resolution 2020-03 declaring a local state				
34	of emergency due to the outbreak of COVID-19; and

36	WHEREAS, Chapter 252, Florida Statutes, authorizes municipalities to declare a state				
37	of local emergency and to waive procedures and formalities otherwise required of				
38	municipalities to take whatever prudent action is necessary to ensure the health, safety, and				
39	welfare of the Village in the event of a state of local emergency; and

41	WHEREAS, it is the duty of the Village to take such protective measures and to				
42 42	coordinate its efforts in support of the public health and safety of the community; and
