ORGANIZATION'S (MPO) BICYCLE PEDESTRIAN  
COORDINATING COMMITTEE (BPCC); AND  
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, The Lee County MPO's BPCC serves an important role in shaping the future of bicycle and pedestrian improvements across Lee County; and

WHEREAS, the Village wishes to protect and support bicyclists and pedestrians throughout Lee County; and

WHEREAS, the Village remains committed to volunteerism as a mechanism for community engagement and continued low staff levels; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Gordon Brown and Mr. Scott Stryker are professional, informed, and active bicyclists and advocates.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Village Council of the Village of Estero, Florida:

**Section 1.** Gordon Brown and Scott Stryker are selected to be the representative and alternate, respectively, for the Village of Estero on the Lee County Metropolitan Planning Organization's Bicycle Pedestrian Coordinating Committee for a term of one (1) year each.

**Section 2.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
