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15 16	WHEREAS , Village Council approved the acquisition and implementation of Community Development software in the 2019-2020 budget. As the acquisition was not started
17	or completed in the prior year, funds are required to be re-budgeted in 2020-2021; and
18	or completed in the prior year, rands are required to be re budgeted in 2020 2021, and
19	WHEREAS, selection and implementation of software is a complex and multi-year
20	effort that will require the assistance of a consultant with specific expertise in this area; and
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22	WHEREAS, cost for the consultant assistance is projected to total \$250,000 over 18
23	months. Funds are available in the prior year surplus for the Building Fee Special Revenue
24	Fund; and
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26	WHEREAS, as provided in the Village Charter Section 8(6)(d), the following transfer
27	of unencumbered appropriations will be added to the 2020-2021 budget.
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29	NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Village Council of the Village of Estero,

32	Section 1. Approves funding for a consultant for assistance with acquisition and
33	implementation of Community Development software of \$250,000 plus \$25,000 contingency
34	in the 2020-2021 budget for this multi-year project. Funds are available in the prior year surplus
35	of the Building Fee Special Revenue Fund.
