RESOLUTION NO. 2021-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE
VILLAGE OF ESTERO, LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA,
ADOPTING THE FINAL LEVYING OF AD VALOREM
TAXES FOR THE VILLAGE OF ESTERO, LEE
COUNTY, FLORIDA, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022;
AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Village of Estero, Lee County, Florida, on September 22, 2021, adopted Fiscal Year Final Millage Rate following a public hearing as required by Florida Statutes 200.065; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Estero, Lee County, Florida, held a public hearing as required by Florida Statutes 200.065; and

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within the Village of Estero, Lee County, Florida has been certified by the Lee County Property Appraiser to the Village of Estero as \$7,196,324,224;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Village Council of the Village of Estero, Florida:

Section 1. The fiscal year 2021-2022 tentative ad valorem operating millage rate is hereby adopted at 0.7700 mills, which is greater than the rolled-back rate of 0.7481 mills by 2.92% and the levy of an annual tax for said year is made.

Section 2. The proposed millage rate is established to provide funding for the fiscal year 2021-2022 budget and the resulting increase in ad valorem tax revenues is necessary to fund various roadway improvements, intersection improvements, bicycle and pedestrian improvements, landscaping and beautification projects and other future projects.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.


