**A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE
VILLAGE OF ESTERO, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE
UPDATED MULTIJURISDICTIONAL PROGRAM FOR
PUBLIC INFORMATION RELATED TO FLOOD
HAZARDS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the Village of Estero joined the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) on September 30, 2015; and

WHEREAS, this entitled the Village to emergency disaster assistance from FEMA and participation in the NFIP Community Rating System to provide residents of the Village with flood insurance discounts; and

WHEREAS, on January 6, 2016, the Village Council adopted Resolution No. 2016-01, approving the Multijurisdictional Program for Public Information (PPI); and

WHEREAS, the Multijurisdictional PPI was created and implemented to broaden the public's understanding of flood hazards and vulnerabilities and to provide options for flood insurance and best practices; and

WHEREAS, all participating communities are required to adopt a resolution approving an updated PPI at least every five years; and

WHEREAS, updating the PPI assists the village to obtain points to help reduce the cost of insurance to its residents.

WHEREAS, the Village Council desires to approve the updated Multijurisdictional Program for Public Information, attached hereto as Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Village Council of the Village of Estero, Florida:

Section 1. The Village of Estero Council does hereby approve the updated Multijurisdictional Program for Public Information, attached hereto as Exhibit A.


Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.


