

5	A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE
6	VILLAGE OF ESTERO, FLORIDA, APPROVING A 3.5%
7 8	CONVENIENCE FEE FOR CREDIT CARD/DEBIT CARD
8 9	USE (CONVENIENCE FEE); AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2015-68; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
9	NO. 2013-08; AND FROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
11	WHEREAS, the Village of Estero was incorporated by referendum held on November
12	4, 2014 and the Village Council was elected on March 3, 2015, pursuant to the Charter
12	of the Village of Estero ("Charter") created by Ch. 2014-249, Laws of Florida; and
13	of the vininge of Estero (Charles) ereated by Ch. 2011 219, Eaws of Frontau, and
15	WHEREAS, the Charter provides that the Village Council shall have the broadest
16	exercise of home rule powers permitted under the state Constitution and the laws of the
17	state; and

19	WHEREAS, the Village Council adopted a fee schedule by Resolution on October 7,
20	2015, establishing fees for permitting, planning, zoning, and other similar fees; and
21	
22	WHEREAS, the Village Council has determined that the use of credit/debit card is
23	more convenient to the public and a convenience fee added to the amount charged helps
24	reduce the cost to the government for using the card; and
25	
26	WHEREAS, a convenience fee of 3% was established in 2015 by Resolution No.
27	2015-68; and

29	WHEREAS, the credit card companies have recently increased the fee to 3.5%; and
30 31	WHEREAS, changes to the fee schedule must be accomplished by Resolution of the
32	Village Council; and
