14	WHEREAS, the Florida Constitution and Florida Statutes provide that municipalities
15	shall have the governmental, corporate, and proprietary powers to enable them to conduct
16	municipal government, perform municipal functions, and render municipal service, and
17	exercise any power for municipal purposes, except when expressly prohibited by law; and
18	
19 20	WHEREAS, Sections 2 and 4 of the Village Charter of the Village of Estero
20 21	("Village") and Section 166.041, Florida Statutes, empower the Village to adopt, amend, or repeal such ordinances and resolutions as may be required for the proper governing of the
21	Village; and

24	WHEREAS, the Village has the opportunity to design, install and maintain a stand-
25	alone local identification marker community aesthetic feature ("Project") on a certain right of
26	way owned by the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT"), which is located at the
27	Village's southern corporate boundary south of Pelican Colony Blvd. on State Road 41 (U.S.
28 29	41) in Lee County, Florida; and
30	WHEREAS, installation of such a community identification and aesthetic feature
31	would serve a valid public purpose; and
32	
33	WHEREAS, FDOT is requesting that the Village, approve, execute and deliver to
34	FDOT a Community Aesthetic Feature Agreement to implement the Project in accordance with
35	the terms and conditions of the agreement.
36 37	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL
38	OF THE VILLAGE OF ESTERO, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:
39	of the village of Estero, floribitits follows.
40	Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct, and incorporated herein by this
41	reference and are hereby adopted as the legislative and administrative findings of the Village
42	Council.

44 45	Section 2. The Agreement designated by FDOT as Community Aesthetic Feature
45	Agreement No. 2022-M-192-00002, between the Florida Department of Transportation and

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46 47 48 49	the Village of Estero for the Project is hereby approved by the Village Council of the Village of Estero, and the Village agrees to fund all costs for the design, installation, and maintenance of the Project in accordance with the terms of the Agreement.
50 51 52	Section 3. The Village Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to apply for any necessary FDOT permits to implement the Project.
53 54 55	Section 4. The mayor is hereby authorized to execute the above referenced Agreement for the Project on behalf of the Village of Estero.
56 57 58 59	Section 5. The Village Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute amendments, extensions, terminations, and novation changes to the Agreement as necessary on behalf of the Village of Estero.
60 61 62 63	Section 5. If any section or portion of a section of this Resolution proves to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional, it shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force, or effect of any other section or part of this Resolution.
64 65	Section 6. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
