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RESOLUTION NO. 2022 - 21

A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ESTERO, FLORIDA, DETERMINING THE PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023, SETTING THE DATE, TIME AND PLACE FOR THE PUBLIC HEARINGS REQUIRED BY STATE LAW; DIRECTING STAFF TO TRANSMIT NECESSARY **DOCUMENTATION PURSUANT** TO REQUIREMENTS OF FLORIDA STATUTES AND THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2022, the Property Appraiser of Lee County, Florida served upon the Village of Estero a "Certification of Taxable Value" certifying to the Village of Estero its taxable value; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statute Section 200.065, requires that within thirty-five (35) days of service of the Certification of Taxable Value upon a municipality, said municipality shall furnish to the Property Appraiser the proposed millage rate, the rolled-back rate, and the date, time and place at which a public hearing will be held to consider the proposed millage rate and the budget for Fiscal Year 2022-2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Village Council of the Village of Estero, Florida:

The proposed millage rate for fiscal year 2022-2023 to be discussed at Section 1. the first budget hearing is hereby declared to be 0.7700 mills (\$0.7700 per \$1,000 of assessed property value). This proposed operating millage rate is greater than the rolled-back rate of 0.7002 mills by 9.97%.

The Village Council hereby sets the date, time and place for the budget Section 2. hearings required by Florida Statutes as follows:
