28	other than the portion of the budget to be funded from sources other than ad valorem taxes and		
29	the percent, if any, by which the proposed millage rate exceeds the rolled-back rate, as required		
30	by Florida Statutes 200.065 and provided below;

32	NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Village Council of the Village of Estero,

35	Section 1. The fiscal year 2022-2023 final ad valorem operating millage rate is		
36	hereby adopted at 0.7500 mills, which is greater than the rolled-back rate of 0.7002 mills by		
37 38	7.11% and the levy of an annual tax for said year is made.		
39	Section 2. The millage rate is established to provide funding for the fiscal year		
40	2022-2023 budget and the resulting increase in ad valorem tax revenues is necessary to fund		
41	various roadway improvements, intersection improvements, bicycle and pedestrian		
42	improvements, landscaping and beautification projects and other future projects.
