RESOLUTION NO. 2023 - 16

A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ESTERO, LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE MILLAGE RATE AND TENTATIVE LEVYING OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE VILLAGE OF ESTERO, LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024; ESTABLISHING THE DATE, TIME AND PLACE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING TO ADOPT THE FINAL MILLAGE RATE AND FINAL LEVYING OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Village of Estero, Lee County, Florida, on September 7, 2023, held a duly noticed public hearing as required by Florida Statutes 200.065; and

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within the Village of Estero, Lee County, Florida has been certified by the Lee County Property Appraiser to the Village of Estero as \$8,396,127,300; and

WHEREAS, a Tentative Budget and Tentative Millage Rate were considered and public comment was provided; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council publicly announced at the public hearing and prior to adoption of the Tentative Budget, the proposed millage rate necessary to fund the Tentative Budget other than the portion of the budget to be funded from sources other than ad valorem taxes and the percent, if any, by which the proposed millage rate exceeds the rolled-back rate, as required by Florida Statutes 200.065 and provided below;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Village Council of the Village of Estero, Florida:

Section 1. The fiscal year 2023-2024 tentative ad valorem operating millage rate is hereby adopted at 0.7500 mills, which is greater than the rolled-back rate of 0.6826 mills by 9.87% and the levy of an annual tax for said year is made.

Section 2. A public meeting and hearing will be held to consider and adopt the final millage rate for fiscal 2023-2024 as follows:
