To follow this transmittal letter is the two-page Summary of Data Compilation matrix which identifies the number of both written and verbal comments received from the public pursuant to the May 24, 2016 Capital Improvements Projects (CIP) workshop. There were 79 respondents who provided written comments and another 31 who made oral comments at the meeting for a total of 110 respondents. To my knowledge, only two individuals provided both written and oral comments; both are included in the attached matrix results.
